Rabbit Creek Elementary, a school of approximately 400 students in south Anchorage, provides a comprehensive K-6 program of instruction that includes three classrooms of special education intensiveneeds students. We provide multi-sensory instruction in reading as a choice in grades 1-3 and tutoring is provided for students who need extra assistance in reading and math. Rabbit Creek partners with the Rabbit Creek Community Association to make before and after-school day care

available at the school. This partnership also helps us provide after-school sports and other activities for our students.

Rabbit Creek takes pride in providing a warm, inviting school atmosphere of high expectations, where students are respected and feel safe. We recognize the school needs community support, so parents and others are encouraged to participate in the educational process. Parent involvement is a hallmark of Rabbit Creek. ## **District Adequate Yearly Progress**

According to the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, ASD is in its seventh year of Level 4 corrective status. In 2011-12, the All Students, African-American, Alaska Native, Two or More Races, Low Income, Disabled and Limited English Proficient student groups did not meet AYP in both language arts and math performance. The Asian and Hispanic student groups did not meet AYP in math performance only. Additionally, the district did not meet the 85 percent graduation rate threshold. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate in the development of school and district improvement plans that address the achievement of all students.
