A PIECE OF HISTORY

813 NORTH BROADWAY ST

While many historical structures grace the banks of the Fox River, the most notable for maintaining its charm and intricate detailing is the 1893 J.P. Dousman Residence. Nestled on the Fox River in the De Pere North Broadway Street Historic District, this well-preserved Queen Anne cottage is architect Frank Piske's creation.

This monument retains its original handiwork, even with extensive renovations and updates. The doors, mantels and fireplaces feature original woodwork and rosette-carved crown molding details. Other retained historic features include parquet floors and leaded windows throughout. Some of the significant updates in the home include custom wine racks to fit the wine cellar on the lower level and a detached three-car garage, which matches the original structure.

813 N Broadway is recognized for its remarkable upkeep as it has won the "Max Franc Residential Historic Preservation Award" from the De Pere Historical Society in 2017. A nod to classic architecture and style, J.P. Dousman Residence provides an appealing Victorian touch to the riverbanks of Downtown De Pere.
